Here's how to earn the Heinz Memorial Chapel patch the Girl Scout way:

#### Steps:

- **1. Discover**—Discover the history represented in Heinz Memorial Chapel at the University of Pittsburgh.
- 2. Connect—Learn more about historical figures and neo-gothic architecture.
- 3. Take Action—Bring the knowledge you gain from this experience to other girls.

# **1** Discover the history represented in Heinz Memorial Chapel at the University of Pittsburgh.

- \*Listen to a Docent-led tour about Heinz Memorial Chapel.
- Ask the Docent what non-denominational means and how it is evidenced throughout the chapel.
- \*Listen to the chapel organ, including listening from different parts of the chapel.

## Learn more about historical figures and neo-gothic architecture.

- Learn about gothic revival architecture and be able to name three unique features.
- Find the stone dedication plaque. Who was the chapel dedicated to and in what year?
- Go on a scavenger hunt and find the following in the transept windows: a volcano, Halley's comet, the Mona Lisa, two Red Cross flags, a spinning wheel.
- Find the window that has the seasons and months of the year and find your Zodiac sign.
- Use the chapel brochure and find the following people depicted in the transept windows and learn why they were leaders: Lewis and Clark, Joan of Arc, Joseph of Egypt, Dorothea Dix, Benjamin Franklin, Galileo, Mary Lyon, and Saint Monica.
- Find the chapel mouse and three more animals or insects carved in wood.
- \*Find out about the significance of the Pickle Pin and ask the Docent for one.
- Learn about trilobites and find one in the marble floor of the chapel.



### STEP 3

### Bring the knowledge you gain from this experience to other girls.

- Form a small group and discuss the themes of the transept windows (tolerance, courage, temperance, and truth) and how they apply to the Girl Scout Laws.
- Create a video or presentation with photos to share with others.
- \*Encourage other Girl Scouts to complete this patch.
