They are attached to the Virginia based 88th Military Police Company, which is helping to train Iraqi police and secure the nation's border. There are 22 women and 148 men with Sgt. Martin's Unit.

The girls in our Troop agreed to donate two boxes each (24 boxes) to the project and to ask if anyone would like to donate a box when they were out selling. Currently, our Troop has 180 boxes of cookies to send to Sgt. Martin and his fellow soldiers. In addition, Daisy Troops 54483 and 50476 also solicited donations for our project. Plus, we will be asking customers if they would like to make a donation during our cookie booth sale on the 27th.
