Junior Girl Scouts must complete all requirements.

1. Spend at least one night at Camp Elliott by attending the Council Wide Camporee, Resident Camp, or an overnighter with your troop.
2. Learn the history of Camp Elliott. Also find out about future plans for possible camp changes.
3. Have a camp scavenger hunt. See how many different items you can locate.
4. Take a hike around the camp and include a visit to the Adirondak shelters, Elliott Lodge, Woods Edge Lodge, Bayberry and Morningside Tent Sites, the creek, the barn and the chimney.
5. Make up a song about the camp. You can use a popular tune and change the words.
6. Learn trail signs and lay a trail using these signs. (Please have the last person in your group pick up the trail). The signs can be found in the *OUTDOOR EDUCATION IN GIRL SCOUTING BOOK* available through the Flo Carr Resource Center.
