Loose Itinerary*:

Wednesday, July 15, 2012: Approximate departure time is 5:00 a.m. We will depart this morning and travel to Savannah, Georgia. Rest and meal stops will be made on your own enroute. Upon arrival we will check into our hotel and enjoy a Pizza & Swim Party.

Thursday, July 12, 2012

After the continental breakfast we will depart for a tour of Tybee Island. Time will be spent at both The Lighthouse and The Marine Science Center. Girls will receive a patch at each stop. Free time for enjoying the beach is included. This afternoon we will return to our hotel to freshen up before the included dinner at The River House.

Friday, July 13, 2012

After the included continental breakfast we will depart for a Savannah Safari Walking Adventure. We will visit the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist and enjoy a tour of Savannah with special focus on the contributions of the Girl Scouts, Juliette Gordon Low and her family and strong women role models. Other stops include Laurel Grove Cemetery and the Davenport House. A boxed lunch is included followed by free time on River Street. Late afternoon enjoy a two hour Dolphin Cruise. Dinner is included this evening.

Saturday, July 14, 2012

After the continental breakfast you will have the entire day at THE BIRTHPLACE . It includes lunch and badges. Dinner is included at The Lady and Sons, Paula Deen's famous restaurant.

Sunday, July 15, 2012

After the continental breakfast we will depart for home. Lunch and dinner stops are included. Return time will be approximately 10:00 PM.

Inclusions: Roundtrip Coach Bus transportation, quad-occupancy lodging, all admission/program fees and meals (excluding Wednesday breakfast and lunch).

Adult Participants: All adults participating must complete the GSWPA volunteer application process (background check and interview) and agree to follow the volunteer policies set forth by GSWPA. Attending adults are considered “chaperones” on the trip, and may be expected to supervise children beyond their own child or troop members in a small group setting.

Rooming Arrangements:

Rooming arrangements will be quad occupancy as follows:

- As per council standard procedure, *girls rooming with other girls*, and *adults rooming with other adults*.
- We *can* accommodate requests for two mother/daughter pairs rooming together. You must have another mother/daughter pair for us to ensure this option.
- We *can* also accommodate requests for complete families of four to room together.
- We *cannot* accommodate requests for rooming of an adult volunteer with multiple unrelated girls (for instance a leader with three troop members).

The standard rate includes quad occupancy. Single, double or triple occupancy is available for additional fees. You must have a “full room” to qualify for this option. For instance, three family members requesting triple occupancy can be accommodated, but one person requesting double occupancy can only be accommodated if they have a second person to share that room.

Girls, Adults and Troops can make requests to room together, but please keep in mind that these are requests, and we cannot guarantee that all requests can be accommodated.

Edinboro, Grove City, Wexford and Canonsburg. Additional stops may be arranged based on location of participants.
