Inclusions: Roundtrip Coach Bus transportation, quad-occupancy lodging, all admission/program fees and all meals (excluding Friday morning breakfast).

Loose Itinerary*:

Friday, June 8, 2012: Approximate departure time is 6:00 a.m. We will depart this morning for Washington, D.C. Our first stop will be the Shanksville Memorial. Lunch is included at the Golden Corral. Upon arrival in Washington you will have time to enjoy the Smithsonian Museum. Dinner is included on the water at Phillips Seafood. After dinner enjoy a Guided Night Tour of the Monuments and Memorials. We will check into our hotel this evening.

Saturday, June 9, 2012

After the continental breakfast we will depart for Arlington National Cemetery. This afternoon enjoy the Girl Scout Activities at the Washington Monument. A boxed lunch is included. We will stop back at the hotel to freshen up before departing of a fun evening at Medieval Times.

Sunday, June 10, 2012

After breakfast we will depart for a tour of Mount Vernon. This afternoon lunch is included at Pentagon City Mall. We will depart for home with a \$10.00 cash dinner stop included. Approximate return time is 8:00 p.m.

*This is a draft itinerary, and may be changed due to unforeseen circumstances. GSWPA reserves the right to make changes to the itinerary as needed.

Adult Participants: Adult participation is dependent on space available once interested girls are accommodated. Interested adults should register as usual, but late registering adults may be refunded if limited adult capacities are reached. All adults participating must complete the GSWPA volunteer application process (background check and interview) and agree to follow the volunteer policies set forth by GSWPA. Attending adults are considered “chaperones” on the trip, and may be expected to supervise children beyond their own child or troop members in a small group setting.

Rooming Arrangements:

Rooming arrangements will be quad occupancy as follows:

- As per council standard procedure, *girls rooming with other girls*, and *adults rooming with other adults*.
- We *can* accommodate requests for two mother/daughter pairs rooming together. You must have another mother/daughter pair for us to ensure this option.
- We *can* also accommodate requests for complete families of four to room together.
- We *cannot* accommodate requests for rooming of an adult volunteer with multiple unrelated girls (for instance a leader with three troop members).

The standard rate includes quad occupancy. Single, double or triple occupancy is available for additional fees. You must have a “full room” to qualify for this option. For instance, three family members requesting triple occupancy can be accommodated, but one person requesting double occupancy can only be accommodated if they have a second person to share that room.

Girls and Troops can make requests to room together, but please keep in mind that these are requests, and we cannot guarantee that all requests can be accommodated.

Pickup Locations:

Pickup Locations will be available in Edinboro, Wexford, Monroeville and Canonsburg. Additional stops may be added based on participation, particularly along the PA Turnpike heading east.
