**Cost:** Girls \$25 each, Adults \$0 (minimum of 12 participants, maximum 24 participants). For any group with adults attending that exceed required ratio, the cost is \$15 per additional adult. All adults must be approved volunteers, and each group must have one adult with CPR/FA/AED certification.

Fee includes skill-building badge, accommodations, dinner, continental breakfast, s'mores, and staff-led activities. GSWPA staff member will be available for check in, dinner, and evening campfire (weather permitting), songs, and s'mores. The staff member will return the next morning for badge activities and a craft. **Note:** Groups are responsible for providing lunch.
