Steps:

- **3. Take Action**—Tell others what you learned about sun safety and remind them to stay safe in the sun.

Why do we need protection from the sun?

A little exposure to the sun each day isn't bad for us. It can provide vitamin D which helps make our bones strong. But when it comes to the sun, you can definitely have too much of a good thing.

- What hours are the sun's rays the strongest?
