

Board Development Committee Member at Large - Position Description

Term: Three-year term beginning with the close of the Annual Meeting in which elected. Members may serve a total of six (6) consecutive years, two (2) consecutive terms. Members are then eligible to serve an additional term after a lapse of one year.

Purpose: The Board Development Committee is responsible for soliciting and recruiting candidates for the Board of Directors, Girl Advisory Committee, National Delegates, and the Board Development Committee.

Responsibilities:

- Attend weekly/bi-weekly meetings from September through December to develop the slate for the Annual Meeting.
- To solicit and recruit candidates for elected positions from all geographic regions in the council.
- To provide to the membership a balanced and diverse single slate for all positions for election, including elected officers, members-at-large, and Board Development Committee members.
- To provide to the membership, in accordance with the time frame established by GSUSA, a single slate of Delegates and Alternates to the National Council Session of Girl Scouts of the United States of America.
- To develop in conjunction with the Board of Directors:
 - board orientation and education materials
 - board development materials
 - methods for identifying needed skills and talents for the corporation Board of Directors and committees
 - methods for succession planning
 - Board annual self-assessment materials
- To conduct Board orientation and Board development training sessions as needed and/or as directed by the Board of Directors.
