

Girl Scout Code of Conduct/Troop Agreement

Girl Scout Promise:

On my honor, I will try:
To serve God* and my country,
To help people at all times,
And to live by the Girl Scout Law.

* Girls may substitute for the word "God" in accordance to their beliefs.

Girl Scout Law:

I will do my best to be honest and fair, friendly and helpful, considerate and caring, courageous and strong, and responsible for what I say and do, and to respect myself and others, respect authority, use resources wisely, make the world a better place, and be a sister to every Girl Scout.

- 1. I/We will follow the principles of the Girl Scout Promise and Law as listed on this Code of Conduct.
- 2. I/We will follow the rules that are made to protect others and myself and to help make sure program activities are safe, fun, and successful.
- 3. I/We will treat other people, myself, property, and equipment with respect.
- 4. I/We will be considerate of the feelings of others.
- 5. I/We will be respectful of my Girl Scout Leaders. I will not argue with my leaders or call them names while under their supervision. I will ask questions calmly and if I am disappointed, I will express my opinion in a respectful manner.
- 6. I/We will not bully or abuse (hit, slap, spit, or any other unwanted touch) my sister Girl Scouts. I understand that violence will not be tolerated and my parents will be notified as well as the parents of any girls involved.
- 7. I/We will remember that others have ideas and thoughts, which may be different from mine, and that their ideas and thoughts are just as important as mine. I will not make fun of the ideas and thoughts of others. I will try not to offend anyone else with my thoughts and ideas.

Failure to follow our Code of Conduct will result in the following corrective action:

First Offense: Review of the Girl Scout Law/Promise and apology, if needed.

Second Offense: Review of the Girl Scout Law/Promise and apology, if needed, and parent will be notified. Third Offense: Review of the Girl Scout Law and Promise with parent and girl, and discussion will be held between parent and leader regarding requirement of parental supervision at all future meetings. Fourth Offense: A discussion will be held between parent and leader regarding potential transition to another participation option.

Note to Troop Leaders: If there are any actions or behaviors that would potentially warrant more severe action, please contact your council support staff.
