# Registration, Payments, and Discounts

The easiest and quickest way to register for a camp session is online. Visit <u>gswpa.org/activities</u> and search for the camp session name that interests your girl.

A \$25-\$100 deposit for camp (depending on the type of camp) is due at the time of registration. Full payment is due by May 15, 2025.

#### Countdown-to-camp discount:

Receive 15% off the total cost of camp when you register by Feb. 14, 2025.

# **Camp Lodging**

Our camps offer a variety of accommodations allowing campers to be close to nature while still enjoying some of the comforts of home.



#### Platform Tents

Found at all camps, these canvas tents sit on raised, wooden platforms and can comfortably sleep up to four girls on cots. The tents are non-heated and do not have electricity or bathrooms, but restrooms are located nearby.

## Lodges

Found at all camps, lodges and non-rustic cabins vary, but are typically heated and include several bunk beds or mattresses inside. Most have indoor or adjacent restrooms, plumbing, and electricity. Lodges and cabins without indoor restrooms have restrooms located nearby.

## **Rustic Cabins**

Found at Camp
Conshatawba and Camp
Hawthorne Ridge, our
rustic cabins are small,
wooden buildings with
bunk beds inside. These are
non-heated and may not
have electricity. Restrooms
are located nearby.

#### Yurts

Found at Camp Redwing, yurts are large, enclosed, rounded shelters. These unheated, semi-permanent tent structures have several bunk beds inside. Our yurts have indoor lighting but no electric outlets or bathrooms. Restrooms are located nearby.




