Dr. Bethany Casagranda is president of the Physician Organization and chief medical officer for Allegheny Health Network (AHN), the first woman and radiologist in these roles. She is also a professor of radiology at Drexel University School of Medicine. Previously, she was the department chair of radiology for AHN over the last eight years.

A musculoskeletal (MSK) radiologist, Dr. Casagranda held positions at the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine and Allegheny General Hospital (AGH), including Radiology Residency Program director and MSK Division director. She collaborates with her orthopaedic associates to care for patients, including elite athletes.

Bethany has dedicated her time and talent to many national society committees, including

those associated with the Society of Skeletal Radiology (SSR), the Society of Chairs of Academic Radiology Departments (SCARD), and the American College of Radiology (ACR). Her professional passions include graduate medical education, wellness of women physicians, and population health.

She has contributed to the field with publications, presentations, and lectures, including at the International Skeletal Society, Radiologic Society of North American, Association of Academic Radiologists, SSR, SCARD, and American Roentgen Ray Society. She has been recognized with several awards, including Teacher of the Year and Pittsburgh Top Doctor (2023, 2024, and 2025).
